

For many people who meet me for the 1st time, all you might see is my Tracheotomy (a tube in my neck that allows me to breath), my weak left side, my walker and my big smile. Soon after you'll understand that I don't speak. Many also think that I don't understand what they are saying or they talk down to me like I am little kid.

My name is Todd and I'm one awesome guy. I'm writing today to set the record straight. I want people to know that I fully understand everything that is being said to me. I understand many types of languages, I use sign language and my iPad to speak. It hurts my feelings when

someone comments on my Trach. I know it's there; I know what it looks like. I see it every day.

I want people to know that I love talking to my friends using the Proloquo2Go app on my iPad. "Handsome William" is the name of the voice that I use. My iPad allows me to communicate with my friends but also important medical needs to my nursing staff. I primarily use my walker and at times my wheelchair. I love playing soccer baseball, going for walks, boat rides, Beyond 21 and watching the entire Fast and Furious movie franchise. Can you believe I even bowl! With the use of a ball ramp and my support worker I get a few strikes!

I was born in October of 1999. I arrived 2 months early and was born with Bardet Beetle Syndrome. Diagnosed with Bardet Beetle Syndrome caused me to be born with High Blood Pressure, problems with my

kidneys and 6 toes on each feet. One toe one each foot was removed when I was six months old. I was also born with Nystagness which means I used my left eye more then my right. Having Bardet Beetle Syndrome also means I never feel full, no matter how much Leat. I wore glasses until grade 10, when I had surgery to help my vision, but instead of making it better, two months after surgery, I went blind in the right eye. Since then I only see light and shadow from that eye.

While I was still being seen at CHEO I had to go every year for an Ultrasound of my Kidneys.

In 2011, when I was almost 12, I left my family to attend a school for the visually impaired and blind, in Brantford, ON. The name of my school is W. Ross

McDonald. This was the only school available for blind and visually impaired people to get a good education. It is the only school that makes all the accommodations needed for education and independence. At W. Ross McDonald they taught me Cane Skills, Life Skills, Independent skills all with all the other classes that most people will take in school.

I have learned to play Global Global which is a sport for visual impaired people. Both sighted and blind people are blindfolded to make the game fair. It's very much like bowling.

THE ROYALS BY SHELBY DIANA, PRINCESS OF WALES WHO WAS DIANA, YOU ASK?

She was born Lady Diana Spencer on July 1st 1961. Diana was born into the British nobility and grew up close the Royal Family on their



Sandringham Estate. She was the fourth child of John Spencer, Viscount of Althorp and Frances Shane Kydd Viscountess of Althorp. Diana was baptized on August 30, 1961, at St. Mary's Magdalene Church, Sandringham. She grew up with three siblings Sarah, Jane and Charles. Her infant brother John, died shortly after his birth one year before Diana was born. Her parents were hoping for a boy to carry on the family line. She became known as Lady Diana, after her father inherited the title Earl Spencer in 1975. At which point her father moved the entire family from Park House to

Althorp, The Spencer seat in Northamptonshire. Diana was the Princess of Wales, was the first wife of Charles, Prince of Wales and mother to William and Harry On November 5th 1981 Diana's first pregnancy was announced. On June 21st, 1982 Diana gave birth to the couple's first child William. She subsequently suffered from postpartum depression after her first pregnancy. Against advice she decided to take William, who was still a baby, on her first major tour to Australia and New Zealand and the decision was popularly applauded. A second son Harry was born on September 15th, 1984, Diana felt she and Charles were closest during her pregnancy with Harry, she was aware their second child was a boy, but did not share the knowledge with anyone including Charles. Diana gave her sons wider experiences than was usual for royal children. She rarely told Charles and the Royal Family and was often not willing to bend when it came to the children. She chose their first given names, dismissed the Royal Family nanny and hired one of her own. Selected their schools and clothing, planned their outings and took them to

school herself as often as her schedule permitted. She also organized her public duties around their timetables. On August 31st 1997, Diana died in a car crash in the Pont de l'Alma tunnel in Paris, while the driver was fleeing photographers. The crash also resulted in the deaths of her partner Dodi Fayed and the driver Henri Paul who was acting security manager of the Hotel Ritz, Paris. Dodi's bodyguard Trevor Rees Jones survived the crash. The

televised funeral on September 6th was watched by a British audience that peeked at 32.10 million which was one of the United Kingdom's highest viewing ratings ever. Millions more watched the event around the world. I admire how she did things her own way. I also admire how she volunteered with lots of charities.
